Rabbi Avi Kannai, is former Rosh Kollel of the Memphis Torah MiTzion Kollel and currently Rav in the Jerusalem neighborhood of Ramot. He is one of the Rabbis affiliated with Tzohar. He also works as a certified clinical psychologist in an outpatient public clinic at north Jerusalem.

Rabbi Kannai spent his military service as a paratrooper in which he was injured in a military operation in Lebanon. After obtaining his Rabbinic Smicha, he studied in the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, earning a Bachelor's degree in general humanities and a Master's degree in Clinical Psychology. He was a research fellow in the Shalem Center and was the scientific editor of the translation of the book "Freud's Moses".
