## Halachic Corner

### *Hilchos Pesukei D'zimrah*

While davening Boruch She'amar one should interrupt to answer Amein to all berachos, and respond as well to Kaddish, Kedusha, Borchu etc. Shulchan Aruch w/Mishnah Berurah 51:2 MB2

However, once one has begun the beracha in the middle of Boruch She'amar (i.e. Boruch Attah etc.) one should not interrupt the beracha even for Kaddish, Kedusha or Borchu. Shulchan Aruch w/Mishnah Berurah 66:MB23, Igros Moshe OC:4:13, S'U Yabia Omer 5:7, Shulchan Aruch Harav 51:3, Kaf Hachaim 18:4, Piskei Tshuvos 51:4

If one completes Boruch She'amar before the chazzan, one should answer Amein to the beracha of the chazzan. Shulchan Aruch w/ Mishnah Berurah 51:2
