Halachic Corner

Hilchos Pesukei D’zimrah

If one completes Boruch She’amar together with the chazzan (or another person) one should not answer Amein, as is the general rule with almost all berachos, because it would appear as if one is answering Amein to one’s own beracha, which we (generally) do not do. Shulchan Aruch w/Mishnah Berurah 51:2

If one completes Yishtabach, Shomer Amoi Yisroel La’ad (at Maariv), or the beracha at the end of Hallel along with the chazzan, one should answer Amein {because many Poskim rule that one should even answer Amein to his own beracha in those instances (although we do not pasken like this L’halacha) we therefore rely on those opinions to rule leniently here, since one is actually answering Amein to another’s beracha. Shulchan Aruch w/Mishnah Berurah 51:2
