**Halachic Corner**

*Hilchos Pesukei D'zimrah*

If one completes Boruch She'amar together with the chazzan (or another person) who completes a different beracha simultaneously, one should answer Amein. Shulchan Aruch w/ Mishnah Berurah 51:2

One may not speak beginning from the start of Pesukei D'Zimrah (i.e. from the beginning of Boruch She'amar) until after Shmona Esrei. Shulchan Aruch w/Mishnah Berurah 51:4

For those who daven Nusach Sefard, one should not even speak while davening the portions of tefillah that precede Boruch She'amar, beginning with Hodu. Likewise, Nusach Ashkenaz should not speak beginning from Mizmor Shir Chanukas Habayis. Piskei Tshuvos 51:2
