Halachic Corner

Hilchos Pesukei D'zimrah

Ashkenazim may interrupt Pesukei D'zimrah to say Modim D'Rabanan, or to say the first Possuk of Shema Yisroel (and Boruch Shem Kivod Malchuso etc.) with the Tzibbur. Shulchan Aruch w/Mishnah Berurah 51:4, 65: MB10

The minhag of Sefardim however, is to only say the first three words of Modim D'Rabanan, and as for Shema, to cover one's eyes with one's hand and continue saying Pesukei D'zimrah with the niggun (tune) the tzibbur is using for Shema, so that it appears that one is being Mekabel Ol malchis Shomayim with the tzibbur. Shulchan Aruch 65:2, Kaf Hachaim 65:6, S'U Yabia Omer 6:4

During Pesukei D'Zimrah one should interrupt to answer Kaddish, Kedusha and Borchu. Shulchan Aruch w/Mishnah Berurah 51:4

The other team struck first with 2 runs in the top half of the 1st inning, but Baron Hirsch stormed back with 4 runs powered by Hirsch Serman's 2 RBI's. The defense was strong in the 2nd inning, and RBI's by Josh Baum and Ariel Cooper gave Baron Hirsch a 6-2 lead. After 6 innings, the team dropped a heartbreaker 8-6.
