Halachic Corner

Hilchos Pesukei D'zimrah

In general one may not interrupt in middle of Pesukei D'zimrah for another mitzvah. However, there are many exceptions to this rule brought by the Poskim. Shulchan Aruch w/Mishnah Berurah 51:4

One may interrupt Pesukei D'zimrah to: say Birchas Hatorah if one forgot to do so earlier; say Krias Shema if one will miss Zman Krias Shema if one waits for the tzibbur; go up for an Aliyah L'Torah if one is the only Kohen or Levi in shul (but he should not speak to tell the Gabbai to make a Mi Shebeirach); speak for a need regarding the Tefillah itself (of which we will cite specific examples in subsequent Halachos). Shulchan Aruch w/Mishnah Berurah 51:4

Baron Hirsch Softball Team Update

After Baron Hirsch dropped a heartbreaker last week, giving its opponent its first win of the season, B.H. was facing the toughest team in the league, led by Scott Segal in the regular season finale. This was the same team which defeated B.H. two years ago for the league championship, and not lost since. Needless to say, B.H. had its work cut out for them if they were going to win tonight and avoid the league basement.

Baron Hirsch was up first, and came out of the gate quick scoring 4 runs in the top of the 1st, while only allowing 2 runs. Each team went down quickly in the 2nd inning, with neither team able to score. B.H. put up another 3 runs in the 3rd, fueled by Ezra Kaplan's double which knocked in 2 RBI's, but the defending champs were relentless, knocking in 3 runs of their own making the score 7-5. Baron Hirsch upped their lead to 10-5, powered by Jon Wogan's double which knocked in 2 more runs. While Baron Hirsch held the other team scoreless the close the 4th, they were shut out in the 5th, and the champs made their move in the bottom of the inning, scoring 4 runs to cut the B.H. lead to 1. With 2 innings to go, would the Baron Hirsch bats stay hot, or would they hit their late game slide and let another win get away?

Fortunately the bats stayed hot, and the team went off for 5 more runs in the 6th, with 2-run doubles by Josh Thomas and Ezra Kaplan along with Hirsch Serman's RBI single scoring Brittney Baum, expanding the lead out to 15-9. Although the other team had something brewing in the bottom of the 6th, Zev Levine's gutsy performance on the mound got the boys of summer out of a jam and kept B.H. up going into the 7th. Although the B.H. bats were silenced in the 7th, web gems by Jon Wogan and Ezra Kaplan sealed the game for Baron Hirsch, and the team wins a thriller, 15-10.

The win gave B.H. a regular season record of 2-4, helps them avoid the league basement, and earned the team the 5th seed in the playoffs. The team now enters the playoffs on a high, and faces the #4 seed and a rematch with former teammate Henry Rothenberg's team in a rematch of the regular season opener. The playoff journey begins this Thursday at the JCC at 6 PM. Come on out and cheer the team on to victory!
