Halachic Corner

Hilchos Pesukei D'zimrah

If one is in middle of Pesukei D'zimrah and realized that he forgot to make a beracha achronah on food eaten before he began to daven, and if he waits until after Pesukei D'zimrah he may no longer be obligated in the beracha because the food will have been digested; one may make the beracha between chapters/paragraphs of Pesukei D'zimrah. Piskei Tshuvos 51:9

If one said the name of Hashem in vain in middle of Pesukei D'zimrah, one is permitted to say the required "Boruch Shem Kivod Malchuso etc." immediately at that time, as is required. Shulchan Aruch w/Mishnah Berurah 206, Piskei Tshuvos 206:24, 51:9
