## **Baron Hirsch Sisterhood presents** **Our 2009 Shalach Manot Project** *Three Mitzvot in One!*

### **What is Shalach Manot?**

The joy of Purim is enhanced when we increase our friendships and create new ones. The mitzvah of Shalach Manot – sending gifts of food – is a beautiful way to achieve this goal.

### **What is the Sisterhood’s Shalach Manot Project?**

To help our congregants fulfill this mitzvah and spread Purim cheer, the Baron Hirsch sisterhood is creating beautiful packages to be delivered on Purim Day (Tuesday, March 10). You can submit a list of members and community leaders, and we will deliver one package to each family whose name is submitted. Each package will contain a list the names of all those sending the Shalach Manot to that family.

### **What three Mitzvot can I fulfill by participating?**

1. You fulfill the mitzvah of Shalach Manot
2. You support the economy of the State of Israel – this year all food products are being purchased from Israel.
3. For each basket, a donation will be made to purchase meals for needy children in Israel.  
*Our goal is to provide 200 meals to children through this project!*

### **Who will you deliver to? What about people who live out of town?**

We deliver to any Baron Hirsch member, as well as professionals and teachers within our local Jewish institutions. A complete roster is enclosed for your convenience. We will only deliver baskets to members who live in the city, or the closer suburbs. For those who live beyond, we will send a beautiful Purim card instead. The list on the final page of the roster indicates members who live beyond our delivery area, and will receive a card instead of a package.

### **What does this service cost?**

The first name on your list will cost \$18. After that, it is just \$5 per name. Our handy order blank will calculate your total cost.

### **What if I forget someone?**

The order blank allows you to sign up for “reciprocity”. This means if anyone included your name on their list, but you forgot to include them on yours, we will automatically add them to your list, and bill you \$5 per additional name.
